Transitional Kindergarten (TK):

- -4 years old on or before September 1, 2023
- -Birthdates between September 2, 2018- September 1, 2019

Kindergarten:

- -5 years old on or before September 1, 2023
- -Birthdates between September 2, 2017- September 1, 2018

Both TK and Kindergarten are <u>full day</u> with early release on Wednesdays

A Typical Day in TK



Goal of TK

Provide the youngest kindergarteners with a readiness year that is developmentally appropriate and will better prepare them for success once they enter Kindergarten.

How to Enroll a Student Using Aeries Online Enrollment

Please follow the instructions below to **enroll a new student**. Make sure you have a valid address within school district boundaries, immunization dates, and an email account to complete this process.

- 1. Go to www.wsdk8.us/enrollment/). Click on the https://parentportal.wsdk8.us/enrollment/).
- 2. Click on the Enroll A New Student button.
- Select Pre-Enrollment (Kindergarten) or Current School Year from the drop-down arrow and then click on Next.
- 4. Read the Required Information details, click Next.
- 5. Enter your name, email address, and account password; click the **Create account** button.
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- Review the Terms of Use and check the "I agree" box on the bottom left. Click Next.
- 7. Enter the **Student's Name**, **Birthdate**, and **Grade**. Click **Next**. Login with your email address and password.
- 8. Enter the **Resident Address information** and click **Next**. After clicking on **Next**, the **Account Created** screen will display and an email will be sent to your email address.
- 9. You will receive an email from: enrollment@wsdk8.us. Check your email account, and verify your email address by clicking the Click Here link in the message sent to you.
- 10. After the email link is clicked on, click **Next** to continue with the enrollment process. Note: you may need to log in with the email address and password entered in Step 5.
- 11. Complete the enrollment process by entering **General Student Information**, **Language Information**, **Resident Parent Information**, **Restrained Individual** (if any), **Emergency Contacts**, **Health Survey**, **Immunization Information**, **Other District Enrollments**, **Authorizations**, and reviewing **Documents**.
- 12. Any information that displays an **Edit** button can be edited **before clicking on the Finish and Submit button**.
- 13. When the Enrollment is completed the data will be submitted by clicking the **Finish** and **Submit** button. After clicking on the button, an email will be sent to the school to notify that a new enrollment is ready to be reviewed. The **Print** button will print out a copy of the enrollment information if you would like a copy for your records.

- Register all children who will be four on or before September 1, 2023
- Children turning four on or before September 1, 2023 will be placed in TK or Preschool
- Children turning five on or before September 1, 2023 will be placed in Kindergarten

- Original birth/baptismal certificate or passport
- Proof of residency (such as a utility bill or car registration)

Beginning this School Year 22/23, Nutrition Services will provide *FREE MEALS* to all students through the Community Eligibility Provision.

Each day, all enrolled WSD students in attendance may come to the school cafeteria to take a *FULL BREAKFAST & LUNCH MEAL_at no cost during the designated meal times. Student's will still be asked to memorize and input in their Lunch Pin numbers for meals taken. Each meal will include nutritious options of Whole Grain Entrees with different proteins, Fresh Fruits and Vegetables, and drinks that include 100% Fruit Juice & Low or Nonfat Milk. All meals are in compliance with USDA's Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010. Please check with your school office for meal service times.

*Meals are free only if 3 or more offered components are taken. One item must be a Fruit and/or Vegetable. Noncomplete meals will incur a separate charge to the student's meal accounts.
