I've lived in our community for over 30 years and devoted my life to health and education. I began my career as a clinical cancer researcher at Children's Hospital of OC (CHOC). My love for science and research quickly became a love for teaching high school students as I moved my focus from lab work to homework.

I began teaching science at the high school level in 2012 and have spent the last decade pouring into my students. Because of my unique background, the district opened its doors for me to develop and implement a biotechnology pathway at Orange High School.

My husband and children all graduated from the same OUSD schools I taught in, and I couldn't be more grateful for the teachers that helped them achieve a quality education.

But as many of my colleagues know, the district has recently turned away from back-to-basics education. Instead, special interests and politics take precedence over parents. This shift in mindset led to school shutdowns that disproportionately hurt low income families and many students have yet to recover socially, emotionally, and academically.

Take for example Orange High School where I taught: only 16.36% of students now meet or exceed state standards in science. The worst part is that success rates across the district have declined dramatically due to poor pandemic policies.

Help develop and implement new STEM programs for our students;

Focus on back-to-basics education and curriculum;

Keep education dollars focused in the classroom, not on special interests.
