As a History teacher at HPHS, Saul was elected six times as Chapter Chair, and continues to fight for the rights of teachers and students.

Saul was awarded the nation's highest honor, a Congressional Gold Medal, for his work as a foot soldier with Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. in Selma, Alabama. In 1963, Saul was recruited to the Civil Rights Movement by the late Congressman John Lewis. Saul is also a decorated Vietnam combat veteran.

Saul served on the Community College Board and obtained a six-year accreditation. Additionally, Saul served three-terms as School Board President. As Board President, Saul secured teachers' salaries and health benefits; implemented educational policies that increased graduation rates and college admissions; and established administrative accountability.

Saul is a retired Compton police detective, and will bring new insights to solving the illegal drug and alcohol problems in our high schools and middle schools. Saul will prioritize the well-being of our students.
